<p>Key theme How are the different religious faiths similar/different?</p> <p>Religious Knowledge Pupils will be looking at an analysing the similarities and differences between the different key religions, this will include the different types of religious buildings, the differences surrounding their beliefs in God and who they worship</p> <p>Philosophical and Ethical Knowledge Pupils will look at some of the main causes of poverty and suffering in the world and will identify the different ways that people can help and support others in need due to this including the work of different religious charitable organisations</p> <p>Essential Prior Learning Primary RE education - Basic knowledge of the main key religions</p> <p>Key Vocabulary</p>	<p>Key theme What are the different beliefs surrounding the creation of the universe?</p> <p>Religious Knowledge Pupils will be discussing the key Christian beliefs and theories surrounding the creation of the universe. These theories will include the theory of design and first cause.</p> <p>Philosophical and Ethical Knowledge Pupils will gain an understanding of the different scientific discoveries surrounding the creation of the world and identify how these theories can discredit or support the existence of God.</p> <p>Essential Prior Learning Key religious beliefs about God, Genesis,</p> <p>Key Vocabulary Darwinism, Evolution, Creation First Cause, Theory of design, Mythology</p> <p>Wider Reading</p>	<p>Key theme Is religion a tool for peace or a reason for conflict?</p> <p>Religious Knowledge Pupils will learn about the islamic belief of Jihad and what the lesser jihad means to muslims as well as the theory of a Just war, Pupils will also look at a number of different religious conflicts and the lasting effects these conflicts have had on the people. Pupils will understand what pacifism is and identify if pacifism is a helpful or harmful quality.</p> <p>Philosophical and Ethical Knowledge Pupils will discuss the different reasons for war and if any of the reasons people go to war are acceptable. They will also look at the laws surrounding wars including Jus in bello and Jus ad bellum. They will also identify and consider the impact some acts of war have on civilians and if these acts are acceptable.</p> <p>Essential Prior Learning Freedom of faith and expression of religion. Y8</p>	<p>Key theme Is persecution always caused by religious unrest?</p> <p>Religious Knowledge Pupils will identify and discuss some of the key religious teaching surrounding treating people well. Pupils will also gain an understanding of Dharma and the Hindu and Buddhist beliefs surrounding suffering. Pupils will identify and discuss the different ways in which people of faith have been persecuted due to their beliefs.</p> <p>Philosophical and Ethical Knowledge Pupils will look at the different ways people with protected characteristics have been persecuted throughout history including the reasons why people are still persecuted in today's society. Pupils will gain an insight into how this type of persecution can affect individuals and why and how this type of prejudice becomes embedded into society.</p> <p>Essential Prior Learning</p>	<p>Key theme Should abortion and euthanasia be illegal?</p> <p>Religious Knowledge Pupils will gain an understanding of the terms sanctity of life and will understand how people of faith see all life as sacred. Pupils will also gain an understanding of the Hindu and Buddhist principles of living and their beliefs surrounding the purpose of life. Pupils will also look at the different religious beliefs surrounding the use of contraception</p> <p>Philosophical and Ethical Knowledge Pupils will also discuss the humanist views on the quality of life and look at the different ways that quality of life can be assessed Pupils will discuss what is meant by body autonomy and will evaluate whether people should have the right to choose what happens to their body in health based situations.</p>
