<p>Key Theme: Identity and Equality in today's society</p> <p>Key Concepts, Knowledge & Skills to be Embedded: Pupils will learn about mental health and emotional wellbeing, including the need for social connections and how these connections can improve mood and wellbeing. Pupils will also learn the different strategies that can be used to build positive wellbeing and reframe negative thought patterns. This includes learning about how physical exercise, socialising and hobbies can improve wellbeing.</p> <p>Pupils will learn about what migration is including the reasons people may migrate from one country to another and some of the benefits migration as on a country .</p> <p>Pupils will learn what stereotypes are and how and why these stereotypes often encourage discrimination and prejudice. Pupils will learn about the different forms of discrimination</p>	<p>Key Theme: Identity and Equality in today's society</p> <p>Key Concepts, Knowledge & Skills to be Embedded: Pupils will learn specifically about male mental health and wellbeing including preconceived ideas surrounding masculinity and how these ideas can have a negative impact on male mental health and has lead to the increase of suicide in the young male population.</p> <p>Pupils will learn about gender stereotypes including why they exist and how these stereotypes can have an impact on people who do not conform to these standards. Pupils will learn about the different gender identities and gender expressions, Pupils will gain knowledge of what life is like for a transgender young person. Pupils will understand what gender standards are and how these gender standards have an affect on people. Pupils will learn how and why the UK is such a diverse country and why we should respect and celebrate people's differences.</p> <p>Pupils will learn about the value of people from different cultures and backgrounds and how we can challenge discriminatory language both online and offline.
