# **Uniform Expectations**

School uniform does not need to be worn. Suitable clothes for the activities involved should be worn and are detailed above. Students should not wear cropped tops, and shorts/skirts must be of a reasonable length. Usual jewellery rules apply.

## **Behaviour Expectations**

It is an expectation that students display exemplary behaviour whilst on the visit and therefore their standard of behaviour around school should be excellent. Any students displaying poor behaviour will be removed from the visit, as student safety is of paramount importance.

#### Medical and medication

Please ensure we have up-to-date medical information for your child. Students are required to have all relevant medications with them on the visit, if they fail to bring them, they may not be permitted to attend, including inhalers. Some journeys are long, especially Harry Potter & Manchester. If your child needs travel sickness medication, please ensure they take it prior to leaving home. If you wish to provide it for the return journey, this must be clearly labelled and given to the member of staff with a note to say you give permission for this to be administered.

# **Cancellation policy**

In line with the school policy, students who do not attend will not receive a refund unless a replacement can be found for the visit.

#### Consent

By enrolling your child on MCAS, you give your consent for your child to take part in the visit and understand the cancellation policy applies. You certify that all contact details and medical information is accurate and you understand that it is your responsibility to inform the visit leader should any of this information changes. You also understand that if you fail to disclose any medical issues then you will be held responsible for any costs incurred as a result of these issues, as the insurance provided by the Academy may be invalidated.

In the event of an emergency, we use the contact details from Bromcom to contact you. Please ensure that if you have made any changes to your contact number that they have been updated through your MCAS account.

By providing consent on MCAS, you agree for your child to be transported in a minibus, should it be required for your child's chosen visit.

At the end of the trip, your child will be responsible for making their own way home from the academy. If your child needs collecting from the academy, please contact the office on **info@airedaleacademy.com** quoting 'AWT – End of Trip Arrangements'.
